






#### the Common European Research Information Format

Conceptual Level (Specification)
 A description of the concepts of research involved entities and their relationships



- Logical Level (Conceptual Model)
   A formal description of the research involved entities and their relationships according to a concept
- Physical Level (Database Scripts)
   A formal machine readable description of the entities and their relationships according to a concept
- SQL Script
  -----CREATE Table Person
  CREATE Table Project
  CREATE Table OrgUnit

 Semantic Layer (Formal Semantics)
 A formalized controlled vocabulary describing a general contextual semantics of the research domain inline with the conceptual, logical and machine description








- Equipment, Facility, Service

- Link Entities (employ existing Vocabularies)

  - -> Publication, Patent, Data
  - -> Postal Address
  - -> OrgUnit (Host, Owner, ...)
  - -> Person (User, Staff, ...)
  - -> Project
  - -> Funding
  - -> Event
  - -> Medium
  - -> Indicator, Measurement











- Overall: euroCRIS members in 42 countries on all continents except Antarctica
- CERIF national standard in 9 countries and used (in some form) in research funding, research performing and research utilising institutions in just about all 42
