- Official body provides either
 - Controlled access to services
 - Open access (web) tools to search & browse

- Verifiable Provenance

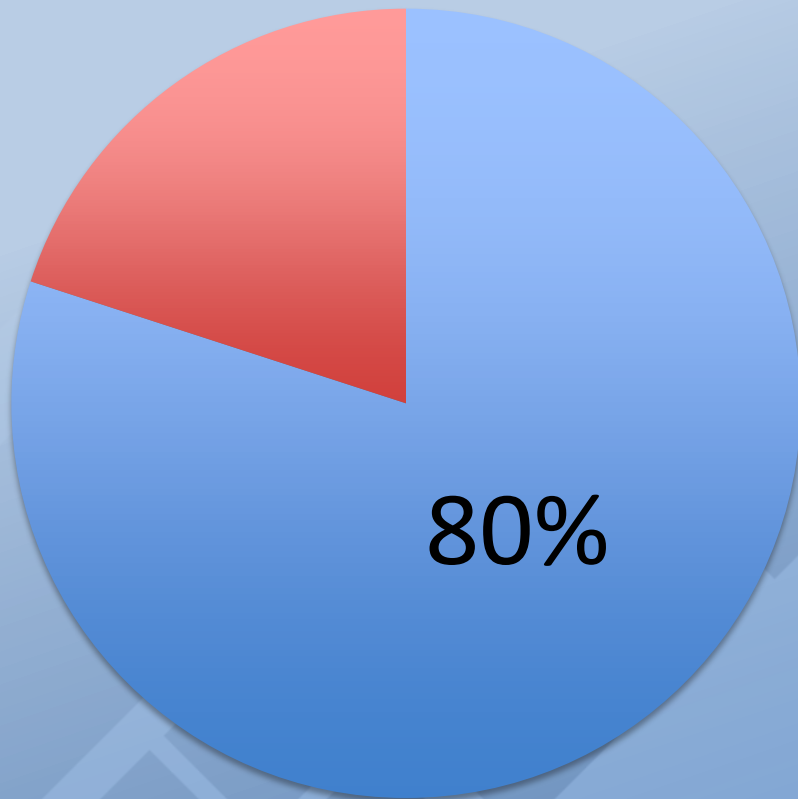

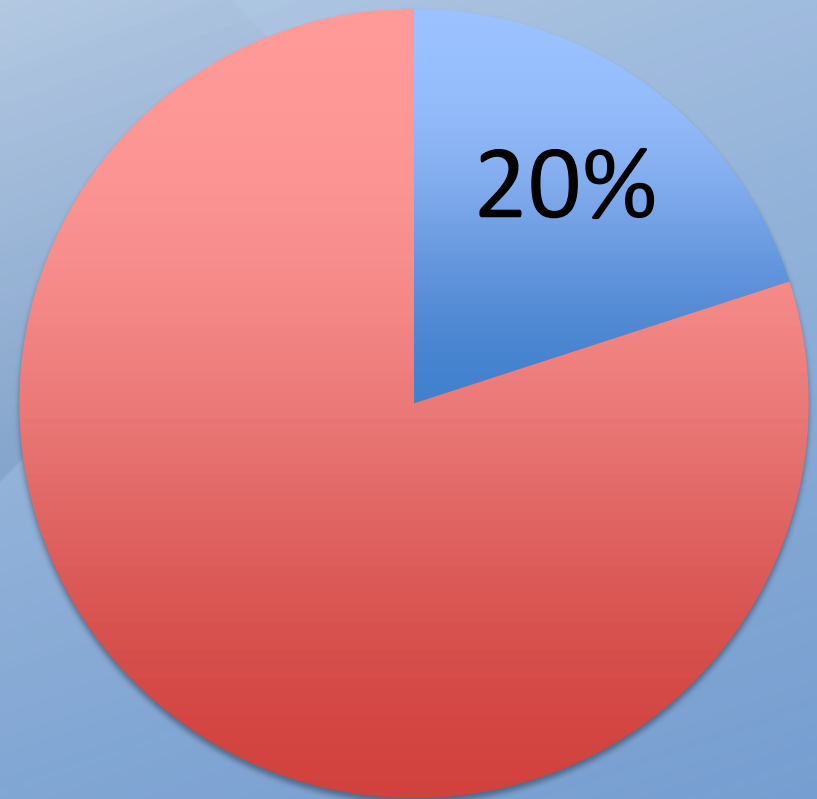


80/20 Rule

Case for OGL

- Open Government License for Public Sector
- Designed for UK public sector data.
- Protects against common concerns.

20%: Formats

- A little data is much better than no data
- RDF is easiest to extend and merge
- Tools can be created to map spreadsheets into RDF
- Common applications can export RDF
- Just don't publish things that can't be open data.

20%: Your end

- Publish what data you can on your organisation's website in a standard format (RDF or CSV)
- Create a simple machine-readable web-document stating
 - what license you're using
 - The URL of your Excel (or CSV, or RDF) document
 - What your university name & logo is.

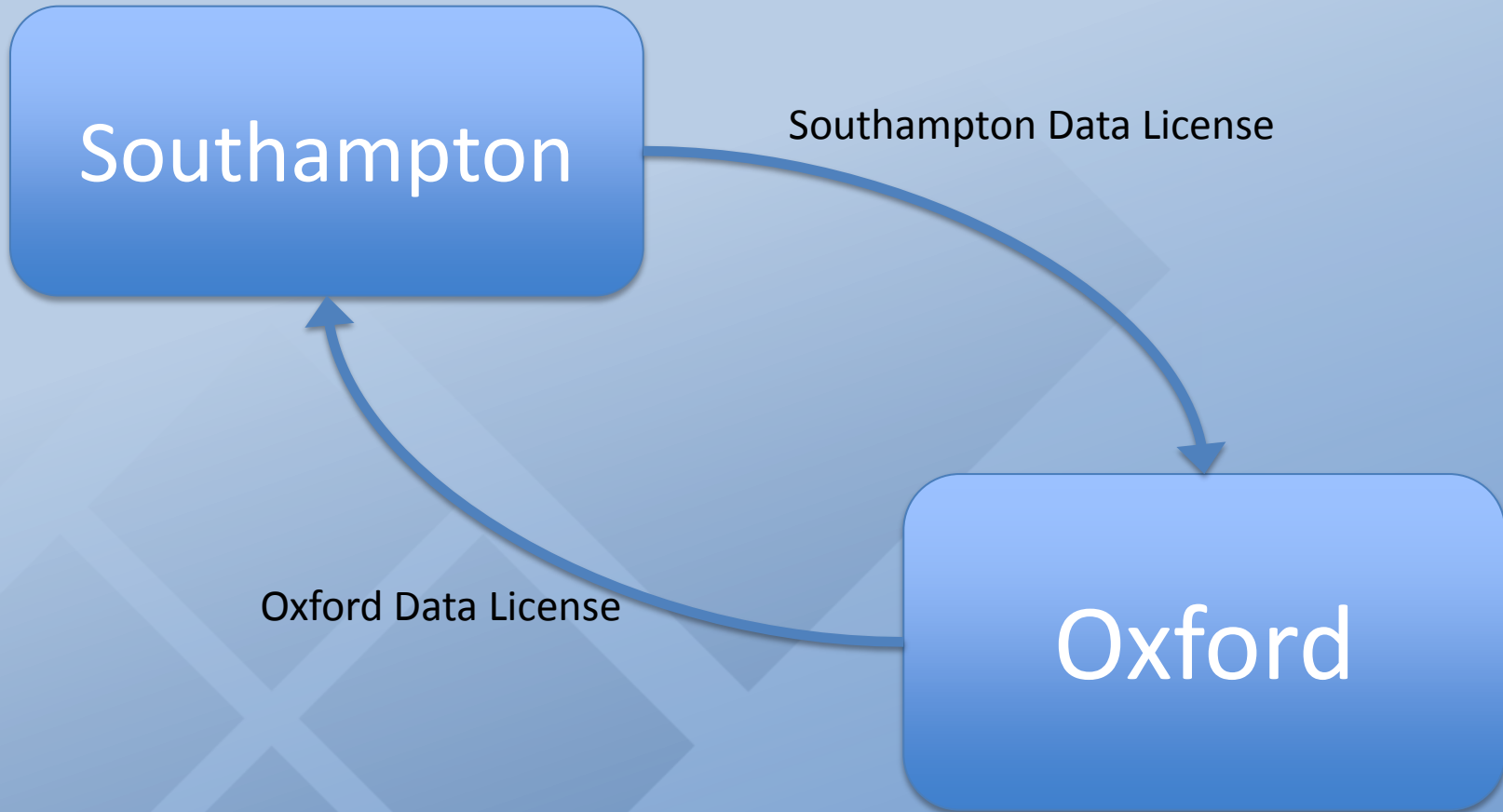

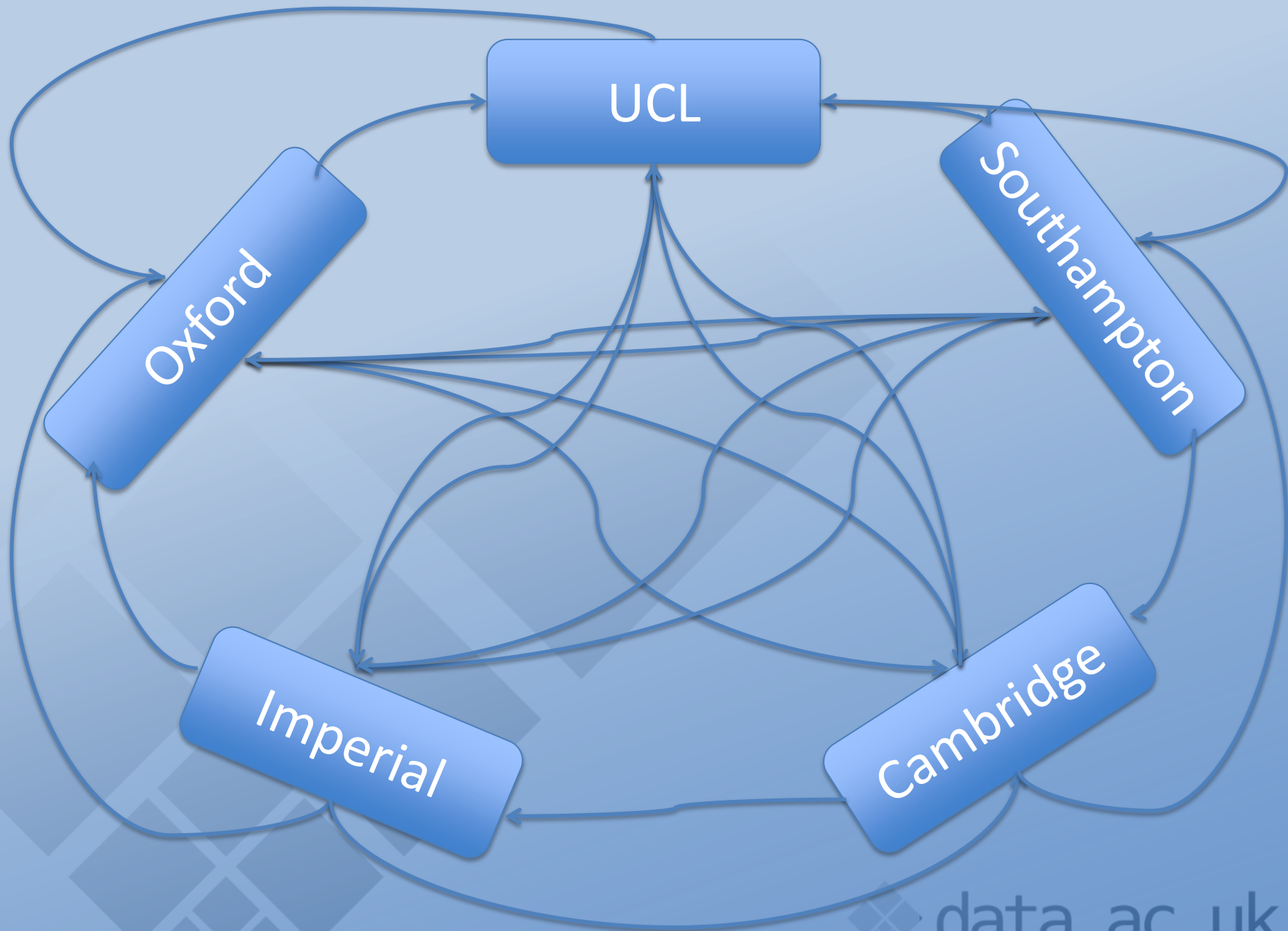
20%: KitCatalogue

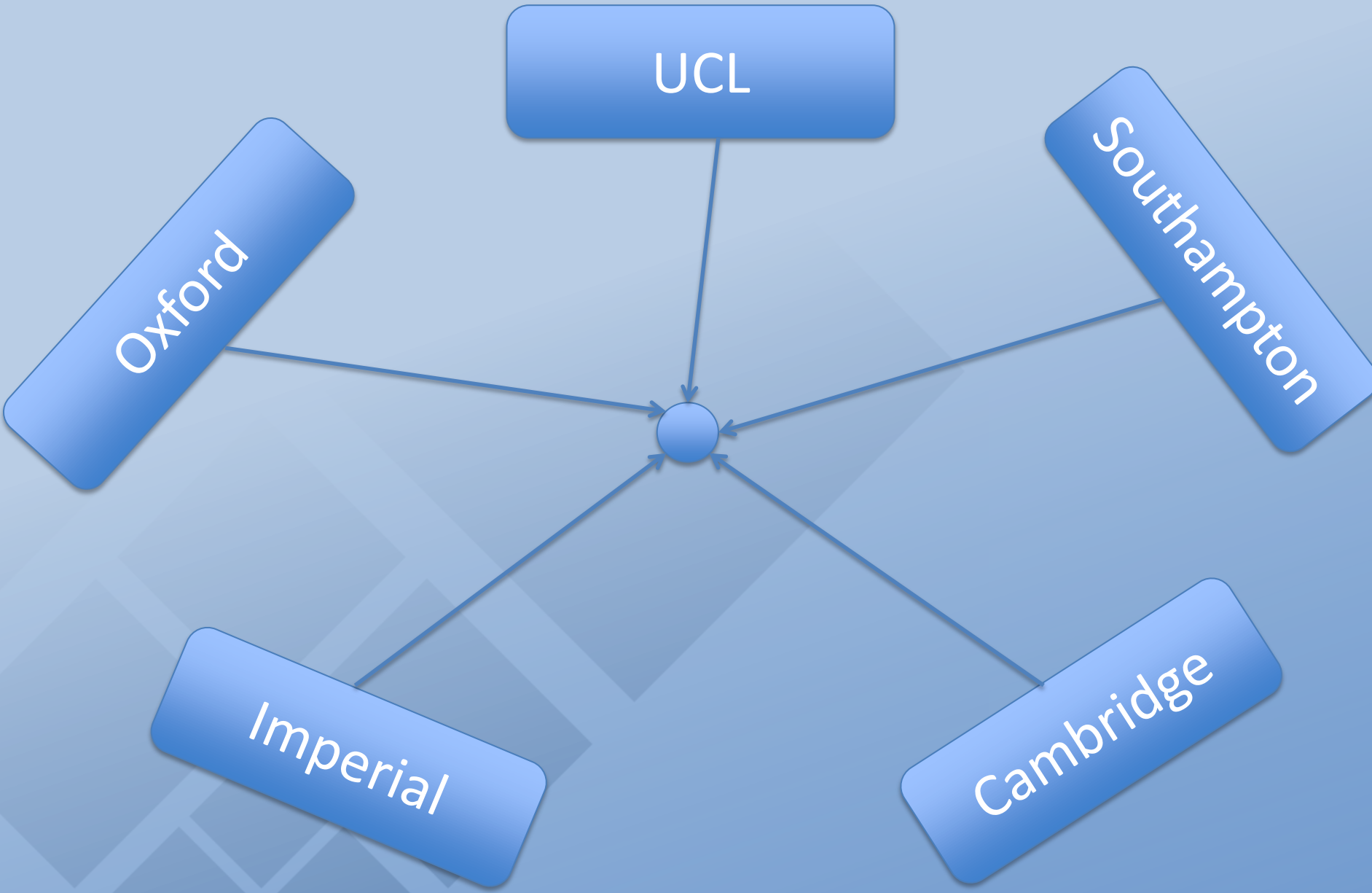
20%: Data.ac.uk

- Ask data.ac.uk to start harvesting it
- Once per day we
 - Download your data
 - Normalise it
 - Aggregate it with data from everyone else
 - Provide a search
 - Provide a download URL for the data as Excel, CSV and RDF
